ManpowerGroup Employment Outlook Survey:

## Italian employers anticipate positive hiring climate for the next three months

At national level, Net Employment Outlook stands at +4%.

**March 12<sup>th</sup>, 2019** – Results for the second quarter 2019 MEOS-Manpower Employment Outlook Survey released today by ManpowerGroup suggest a positive start of 2019 for the Italian Labour Market. With a seasonally adjusted Net Employment Outlook of +4%, Italian employers anticipate the strongest hiring climate reported in eight years for the April-June 2019 time frame.

### Regional comparisons

Payrolls are forecast to grow in three of the four regions during the second quarter of 2019. North East employers report the strongest hiring prospects with a Net Employment Outlook of +10%, while some job gains are also anticipated in Middle Italy and South/Islands regions, with Outlooks of +2% and +1%, respectively. Meanwhile, North West employers anticipate a flat labor market with an Outlook of 0%.

Hiring intentions strengthen in three of the four regions when compared with this time one year ago. The North East Outlook improves by 6 percentage points, while Outlooks increase by 5 and 4 percentage points in the South/Islands and Middle Italy, respectively. Meanwhile, hiring plans remain relatively stable in the North West.

### Sector comparisons

Employers in seven of the 10 industry sectors expect to add to payroll during the next three months.

The strongest hiring prospects are reported in the Manufacturing sector with employers reporting a Net Employment Outlook of +9%. Elsewhere, employers forecast modest job gains for the Agriculture, Hunting, Forestry & Fishing sector where the Outlook is +4%, and in both the Mining & Quarrying sector and the Public & Social sector, with Outlooks of +3%. However, employers in two sectors expect to trim payrolls, most notably in the Restaurants & Hotels sector where the Outlook is -4%.

## Organization-Size comparisons

Employers expect to grow staffing levels in all four organization size categories during the forthcoming quarter. Large employers report the strongest hiring plans with a Net Employment Outlook of +20%. Elsewhere, Outlooks of +10% and +7% are reported by Small- and Medium-size employers, respectively, while Micro employers report a cautious Outlook of +1%.
